Slater & Gordon continues investigations on behalf of St Helen's oyster farmers

National law firm Slater & Gordon is continuing its investigations on behalf of oyster farmers at St Helens in north-east Tasmania.

A small number of oyster farmers from St Helen's originally sought legal advice in 2005 after suffering significant damage to their stock and subsequent financial losses.

The investigations so far, which have been mainly scientific, have identified a suite of toxins emanating from *E. nitens* hardwood plantation timber in the George River Catchment which feeds the St Helen's estuary.
